Commissioner Murray indicated that all consent agenda items could be voted on as one packet. MSP to approve Spring 2005 sports schedules and conference minutes.

- III. Commissioner's Report: Dale Murray
 - A. Appeals:
 - B. Decorum: Commissioner Murray re-emphasized decorum and coaches behavior.
 - C. Sanctions: Gavilan College has complied with all requirements and will be taken off supervision status.
 - D. Program Additional/Deletions: Mission dropped W Soccer added W Softball 2005. San Mateo will not have W Tennis 2005.
 - E. Form 3's: All Form 3's are to be submitted electronically prior to Sport Season. Form 1's can follow in the mail. If additional athletes are added after Form 3 is submitted, do not submit again. Purpose of this database is to determine if athletes have played at another community college.
 - F. COA Interpretations: At the Aug 20. Conference Commissioners Meeting it was agree upon to treat every removal of an athlete or coach as an ejection rather than disqualification. Athlete or coach must sit out next game. P. Moore noted that in Baseball many of the disqualifications are not related to decorum issues.
Activities of Basketball- Out of season basketball shoot-outs. Commissioner Murray ruled that any out of season competition especially in the semester of sport shall be a violation of the practice rule 3.5.2. This is effective 10:17am October 1, 2004. D. Murray is defining this participation as practice rather than competition. This is a Coast Conference interpretation and decision.

- IV. Conference Business: Dale Murray
 - A. Baseball Business. P. Moore discussed changes to Baseball supplement. Batting practice shall take place on the field. The same facilities used in BP by the home team must be available to the visitors.

Visitor's bull pen must be similar height, slope and maintained as the home team's bull pen. Umpire will decide if there is a dispute.
All conference teams must be ranked by position based on overall stats for All American selection purposes. Motion approved.

B. Bylaw 2, Section 4. D. Murray discussed proposed change to Bylaw 2 Section 4. Option 2 was passed. If a college starts playing the conference schedule, and finds that it cannot play the remaining games due to a lack of players, all conferences contest become forfeit losses. Motion approved.

D. M-Basketball Play-offs. T. Marcopulos discussed the request by Men's basketball to consider adopting a Conference Tournament for the 2005-06 season and beyond. Motion approved.

E. DVC Tennis Request. D.Murray discussed the request by DVC to have Men's and Women's Tennis teams be hosted by the Coast Conference. Motion denied.
