Women's Basketball Supplement

**1. Ball:** Spalding Top Flight 1000 28.5

- 2. Warm up:**
- a) Home team must provide the facility for a minimum of at least 30 minutes.
  - b) Home school must provide warm up balls (at least 6 for visitors)

**3. Pre-Game, Half-Time and Post Game:**

Home team must provide a space with chalk, chalkboard, and eraser for pre-game and half time.

- 4. Uniforms:**
- a) Light will be used for home games.  
Dark will be used for away games.
  - b) Specify on roster, which is light and dark.
  - c) Color changes may be made if both coaches involved in agree.

**5. Roster/Game Schedule:**

Send your roster and game schedule to all conference schools prior to your first contest. Roster will include: number, numerical order, name, position, height, eligibility and hometown.

**6. Game Times and Game Changes:**

Game times are 5:30 and 7:30 unless Athletic Directors have a prior agreement.

All game changes (game time or site, etc.) will be put in writing with Athletic Director's and coaches signature from both schools. Anytime there is a game change, a revised schedule will be sent out to all other league schools. Coaches who are scouting, etc. Cover yourself by calling or confirming game.

Conference Schedule-Once the conference schedule has been approved by conference members, changes in game dates require approval from all coaches and athletic directors in the conference. Changes because of weather conditions can be resolved between the coaches and athletic directors from the two colleges involved.

**7. Ice And Plastic Bags:**

Ice and ice bags must be available in case of injury (not necessary for drinking). No ice packs.

**8. Films:**

You must keep all films and stats within the league, (do not sent to other schools for scouting purposes). Your school or representative may not video tape a game unless your team is playing that game.

**9. Scores/Stats:**

Each team is responsible for their own stats during all league games. Home team is to call or email the conference sports information director immediately following the game with results. The conference Sports Information Director will then report standings to the league schools weekly.

**10. Fee At Game:**

Left up to the individual schools. Please note your schedules so fans can be notified.

**11. Towels:**

Each school provides their own towels at all games. Home schools will provide towels for the bench.

**12. Basketball Rep:**

Coaches will vote on coach's representative.

**13. Basketball Rules:**

**14. Supervision At Games:**

School official must introduce themselves before the game begins to the visiting coach and be in charge of game supervision.

**15. Scores And Table:**

- a) Your head scorer must be noted to the visiting team before the game starts.
- b) Home team must provide a spot at the scorer's table for visiting team scorer.
- c) Attempt to get more consistency on 30 second clock

**16. League Meeting:**

Meeting will be held on 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday after league Contest.

**17. Seeding Representative:**

League coaches will vote on a seeding representative. It does not have to be same as the conference representative. Seeding meeting will be on Monday following the league meeting.

**18. Seeding Teams For State Playoffs:**

First place automatically qualifies for State Tournament. All teams wanting to be considered to be selected into the state tournament need to submit their power rating fact sheet to the seeding representative at the league meeting.

**19. Tie Breaking Procedures:**

- 1) In case of the tie head to head competition to be used first.
- 2) If that does not break tie the team who beat the highest place finished league with the best record to be used next (ex. If one beat the highest finisher twice and the other beat the team once the two would be seeded higher) This procedure to be followed in deciding order.
- 3) If the #1 and #2 doesn't break the tie the team with the highest non-conference power

- rating will be used to break the tie.
- 4) If still tied a flip of the coin will be used to determine highest seed.

**Conference order will be determined by league finish. Unless individual coach agrees to move their team to a lower seed to allow a more seedable team to move up in the order.**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place Team: A) M.V.P and two All-Leaguers for a total of 3 members.**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Team: A) Two All-Leaguers**
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team: A) Two All-Leaguers**
- 4<sup>th</sup> Place Team: A) One All-Leaguer**
- 5<sup>th</sup> Place Team: A) None**
- 6<sup>th</sup> Place Team: A) None**  
**(Two Selections will be voted on by the coaches.**  
**Each coach may nominate one player from their team.)**

**Note:**

- 1. Ten All-League Players (M.V.P is included in this group)**
- 2. Coach of the year goes to the Championship team.**
- 3. MVP comes from the 1<sup>st</sup> place team.**

**All Freshmen Team**

**Coaches will vote for the 5 all freshmen team. One player will be named Freshman Player of the Year.**

### **All State nomination**

- 1. Coaches will identify from the All League list their nominations for All State consideration.**
- 2. Conference coaches will then rank those All State nominations.**
- 3. Coaches nominating their player's must have the All State nomination form from the CCCWBCA directory filled out.**
