The meeting started at 9:30 am. Members were welcomed by the Chair and new attendees were introduced by their athletic directors.

**CONSENT AGENDA;** The minutes of the Sept. 29, 2006 conference meeting and the Financial Report dated March 19, 2007 were approved as submitted.

## **SPORT SCHEDULES/SUPPLEMENTS/RECORDS/OFFICIALS ASSOC.**

Discussion took place on the status of sports at each college. Lassen College is adding Cross-country for Fall 07.

Basketball/MW-Fran Babich distributed a proposed schedule for the 2007-08 season. Fran noted the changes in the schedule from the 06-07 season, namely the COR away games will be on Thursdays-Saturdays.

The 2007-08 schedule was approved as submitted. Game times will be 5:30 for the women and 7:30 for the men. The 2008-09 schedule will be presented at the May 4<sup>th</sup>. GVC meeting. The women's basketball coaches requested some changes to their supplement. After some discussion it was MSC to table their request until the May meeting when the basketball coaching reps can be in attendance to explain their proposed changes. The men's supplement remains the same as the 2006-07 supplement.

Volleyball-Emil Ruby presented his proposal for volleyball officials, explaining the changes from last year and the rationale for the recommended changes. After considerable discussion and recommended changes, it was agreed that the recommendations will be presented to the officials by Emil and the proposal will be re-written to reflect the agreed to changes. The Chair asked that the proposal be extended to three years to reflect the contracts for other sports.

Gary Houser distributed the proposed 2007 volleyball schedule. After a brief discussion it was MSC to accept the schedule as proposed. The supplement for 2007 remains the same as last year.

**COA Call for Input**-The proposed legislation for consideration at the COA Convention in April was discussed and voted on by the membership. The voting results will be forwarded by the Chair to the COA office along with the recommended comments.

**Late Starting Classes**-Dennis Roberts introduced this topic for discussion by the members. Discussion only, no action taken.

**Eligibility seminar with college staff**-Discussion took place on this item to see if we could schedule a seminar to help our eligibility staff with this responsibility. Dennis will talk with Linda Sanchez for her input and recommendations.

**Misc.** Commissioner evaluation form. Each Athletic Director will fill out the form and return it to Fran Babich prior to the May 4<sup>th</sup>. GVC meeting.
