The meeting convened at 9:01 am. The Chair welcomed all members in attendance and introduced Carlyle Carter, Executive Director of the COA. Conference members introduced themselves and identified their colleges.

CONSENT AGENDA; The minutes of Oct. 7, 2005 and the Financial Report dated March 20, 2006 were approved as submitted.

Executive Director: Carlyle Carter addressed the membership apprising them of his activities since arriving in California in August. He addressed some issues that he felt important and answered all questions from the members.

SPORT SCHEDULES/SUPPLEMENTS/RECORDS/OFFICIALS ASSOC.

Volleyball-Gary Houser distributed copies of the proposed schedule. It was MSC to accept the proposal as submitted. The Chair will contact the sports rep to inquire about the supplement.

Soccer-Joe Hash distributed the proposed women's soccer schedule. After some discussion, it was MSC to accept the schedule as proposed. The conference is in the 3rd. year of our agreement with the officials.

Basketball-Fran Babich re-introduced the basketball schedule for 2006-7 which was approved a year ago as part of a 2 year proposal. Scott Johnson will be in attendance at our May 5th meeting to present his proposal for official's fees.

COA LEGISLATION:

Proposed legislation was discussed and voted on by conference members. The Chair will forward the votes to the COA office.

GENDER EQUITY

Fran Babich gave a comprehensive report on the COA Gender Equity Committee.

COA/CCADA SUBCOMMITTEE ON CORPORATE SPONSORSHIPS

Gary Houser and Joe Hash had no report since the committee has not been active since Stu Van Horn has assumed a different position. Carlyle brought members up to date on the current status of the position and possible opportunities with corporate sponsors.

HOME SUPERVISION OF CONTESTS

Members discussed the increase in negative behavior by sports fans/athletes at athletic events and actions by host colleges that could lead to a more positive outcome. One suggestion was the use of athletes from the host college that are clearly identified, to act as guides/hosts for the visiting team. Supervision by the host college, is responsible for crowd behavior before, during and after the contest.

League Minder Program:

The Chair introduced this topic and Joe Hash explained it in detail since Joe had initial contact with the vendor. After discussion, it was determined that interested colleges should contact the vendor if interested.

PROGRAM REVIEW-LASSEN COLLEGE/COR

The Chair reported on the status of the program review process for the two colleges and members volunteered for specific standards for the April 12th visit at COR.
