The meeting convened at 9:00 a.m. Members were welcomed by the Chair and new attendees were introduced.

Consent Agenda-The minutes of March 21, 2005 were approved as submitted.

Sport Schedules/Supplements/Official's Assoc:

Volleyball- Kelly Brazil addressed the volleyball schedule as it pertained to the Wednesday/Friday format. After some discussion, it was MSC to approve the proposed schedule. The Chair informed members that Emil Ruby will be contacting each college in the next two weeks to request schedules and talk about assigning officials for next season.

Soccer-Rip Ash representing the women soccer coaches gave the background on the Tuesday/Friday schedule. After considerable discussion, it was MSC to approve the 2005 schedule but also instructed the coaches to present a conference schedule for 2006 that includes Saturday matches rather than Friday matches.

Men's Basketball-Kele Fitzhugh led the discussion concerning recommended changes to the 2005-06 supplement. The trainer proposal will be changed to reflect a "strong recommendation" that a certified trainer be available for both teams. The supplement was approved with the recommended changes. Conference members had considerable discussion concerning athlete's behavior after the completion of conference games. The basketball coaches will continue to work on their proposal and it was recommended that the conference look at this issue for all sports.

2005-06 Conference Dues-The Chair reported that the dues for next year will remain the same. Invoices were distributed to each college.

SCOPE-Fran Babich gave an overview of the purpose of SCOPE and the importance of having all physical educators joining the organization at each of the member colleges.

Conference Sports-Each member college reported on the various sports being offered for the 2005-06 season. Members also discussed those sports they wish to add when funds become available.
