Spring Meeting @ Moorpark College, January 25, 2003

Meeting Minutes:

1. 9:00 a.m. call to order.
2. **Executive Members Present:** President, Will Thurston; Secretary/Treasurer/Bay Valley Conference South Rep, Kara Giannetto; Bay Valley Conference North Rep, Karen Linde; Orange Empire Conference Rep, Betsy Smith; Western State Conference Rep, Larry Cook; C.O.A. Rep., Susan Yates.
3. All were in favor of accepting Meeting Minutes from 11/16/02 CCCLGCA Business Meeting held at La Purisima Golf Course prior to State Championships.
4. Treasure's Report – all were in favor of refunding Will Thurston for State Tournament Banners and Fleece Lined Golf Shoe Bags. Total \$780.00
 - a. Committee discussed options for 2003 State Banners. Karen Linde, Sierra College, is hosting State and she'll look into having State and Nor-Cal Perpetual Banners created, as well as a smaller version listing past Championship Teams that will go to the previous Championship Team at end of event.
 - b. CCCLGCA membership drive to include 2-year Golf Coaches, Assistant Coaches, 4-year Coaches and perhaps previous players of the Community College golf programs.
5. Women's Golf Guide (Form-5's for approval before 2/1/03). All sections were filled in including the proposed change/addition/or deletion; intent; rationale; impact gender equity and financial impact. Anything in " " is a summary of newly adopted wording, however it may not be exact.
 - a. 3.11 By-Law's
 - i. Corrected the wording to reflect the procedure we are and have been using. "...conference play must end four (4) Wednesday's prior to Thanks Giving....post-conference play must end two (2) Wednesday's prior to Thanks Giving."
 - b. 2. A Women's Sport Guide
 - i. For consistency we added, "conference competition ends four (4) Wednesday's prior to Thanks Giving."
 - c. 4.2 B Regional Site, Date, Time of Sport Guide
 - i. Changed post-conference start time and wording to provide consistency with events each year, to ensure, as much as is possible, the completion of 18-holes per day, holding the golf course to the times/dates they quoted. "The event must start by 10:01 a.m. each day. The tournament director (for regional events and state championship) will provide the Executive President of CCCLGCA a signed contract from the golf facility six-months prior to the event."

- d. 4.2 C Pairings
 - i. Cut. Information now exists under 6.3. Consistent for regional and state.
- e. 4.2 D
 - i. “coaches” no longer banned from playing course and changed “two-weeks” to one-week for players. Intent to improve coaches ability to prepare players for competition and course conditions, and to improve pace-of-play. “No practice or competition rounds of golf will be allowed by players on courses to be used for the season’s regional or state competition during one (1) week prior to event, except the home team may use that course for its practice.”
- f. 5.2 A State Site and Date
 - i. delete and add, “the state championship shall be held on the third Sunday and Monday or Monday and Tuesday in November. It shall consist of 36-holes to be played over a two (2) day period.”
- g. 5.2 B State Site and Date
 - i. Same as revised regional 4.2 B for consistency.
- h. 5.2 D State Site and Date.
 - i. Same as revised 4.2 D for consistency.
- i. 6.1 F Playing Details and Officials
 - i. “There shall be no substitutions after the start of each post conference tournament.” No substitutions beyond your six-declared players. Declare six if you have six, even if you’re not sure they can attend. If they are not declared prior to the start of event, they cannot participate. This applies to regional event also.
- j. 6.1 I Cell phones, pagers, etc.
 - i. Revised previous harsh consequences of using or ringing of cell phone on the course. “1st offense is warning; 2nd offense is 2-stroke penalty; 3rd is automatic D.Q.”
- k. 6.2 A & B Scoring
 - i. 6.2 A – “Team championship will be determined by adding lowest four (4) of (6) players scores for each stipulated round”.
 - ii. 6.2 B – “Individual champion decided by participants lowest cumulative score for the event”.
- l. 6.3 A Pairings
 - i. add “regional” to sentence. “The pairings for the regional and state tournament shall be as follows:” “On the first day, the individuals shall go out first in reverse order of how they qualify. The team qualifiers will then follow the individual qualifiers and will be paired in their respective line-up order. On the second day, the order will be reversed with the teams going out first. Special note: at the state tournament two (2) players from the south will be paired with two (2) players from the north.”
- m. NEW ADDITION TO Section 6.1 – Playing Rules

- i. 6.1 I “Spectators, if allowed on the course, must use cart-path or reasonable distance off the fairway. Spectators interfering will be removed from site by a committee member.”

- 6. Coaches to “coach anywhere except greens or bunkers.” (Stan Gonta topic from 11/16/02)
 - a. Adopted the following coaching guidelines under 6.1 J:
 - i. “Two designated coaches can coach players from green to tee. The designated coaches are not allowed to contribute to rules decisions or assistance during such play.” Also, tournament directors are asked to create identifying name badges for the one or two coaches declared for each event.

- 7. “State Coach of the Year” (Kara Giannetto topic from 11/16/02)
 - a. Added to CCCLGCA Constitution #7. 7. “State Coach of the Year criteria: (1) an active CCCLGCA Member in good standing, (2) Coach of the Year of their respective Conference or a “write-in” on ballot at Annual CCCLGCA Business Mtg., (3) Award presented at State Banquet.” Reminder, each active CCCLGCA Member may vote for coach of the year if present at Annual Business Mtg. and is eligible to play in Coaches Tournament at State Tournament with/or without a team or individual competing!!!

- 8. C.O.A. Web Page Rankings (Kara Giannetto topic from 11/16/02)
 - a. To better follow the progress of all California Community College Women’s Golf Teams all women’s golf coaches are encouraged to fax, send or email win/loss record to Kara Giannetto the 3rd, 6th and 9th week of competition, include Conference Champions as soon as available. Please send win/loss record for team and the lowest individual score only. Contact Kara for more info: giannettokara@fhda.edu / 650-949-7285. The information will be compiled and forwarded to C.O.A sports web master to be posted on the Women’s Golf Page.

- 9. “Hall of Fame” (Will Thurston topic from 11/16/02)
 - a. Added “Director of Hall of Fame” title under Sec/Treasurer of CCCLGCA Handbook. Position is “vacant” until voting at 2003 State Business Mtg. The idea is to have criteria determined by 2004 when C.C.C. Women’s Golf will be turning 10 years old!

- 10. Reports from C.O.A Rep. – Susan Yates, Fresno City College
 - a. The information below is regarding plan for our sport to meet compliance standards required of all sports by C.O.A. for post-season participation numbers.

i. Regional events are required to have 40% of total participants.

Nor-Cal

Currently 60 Participants during season
 Currently 24 *team participants at regional’s
 *based on 6-members per team
 Currently 12 individual qualifier’s

So-Cal

Currently 102 Participants during season
 Currently 36 *team participants at regional’s
 *based on 6-members per team
 Currently 18 individual qualifier’s

Total participants 36 of 60 = 60%

Total participants 54 of 102 = 52.9 %

OVERALL Need to reduce total players (90) to (73) for a 45% of total participants in state. As conferences increase in size we may eventually get back to our current post-conference format.
