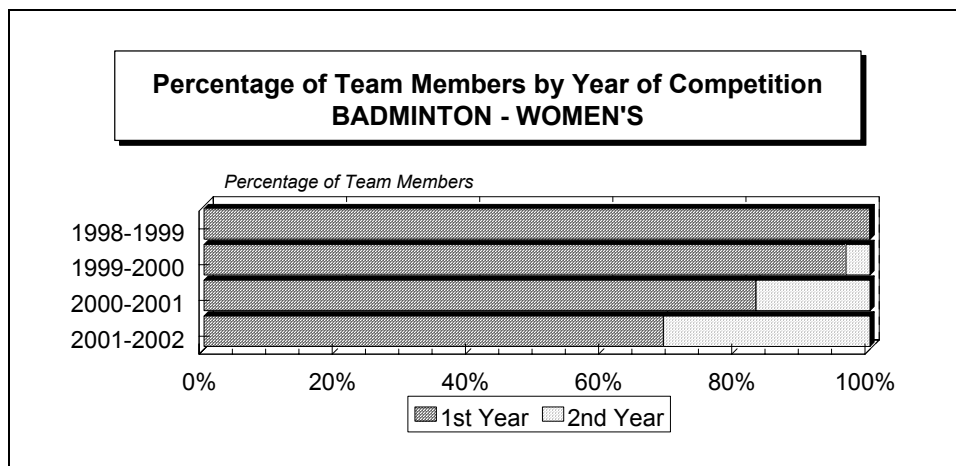

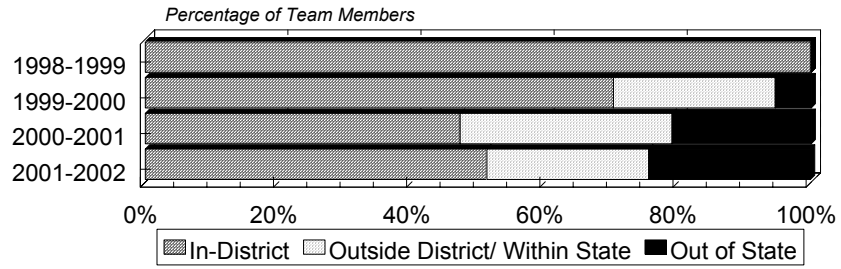

Badminton teams realized an increase of second-year players from 4% in 1999-2000 to 17% in 2000-2001 and to 31% in 2001-2002. Two years ago, a large majority of players (70% in 1999-2000) came from within the district; however, by 2001-2002, that percentage dropped to 51%, with many more players coming from outside the district and outside the state as is the case with many of the other more established sports.

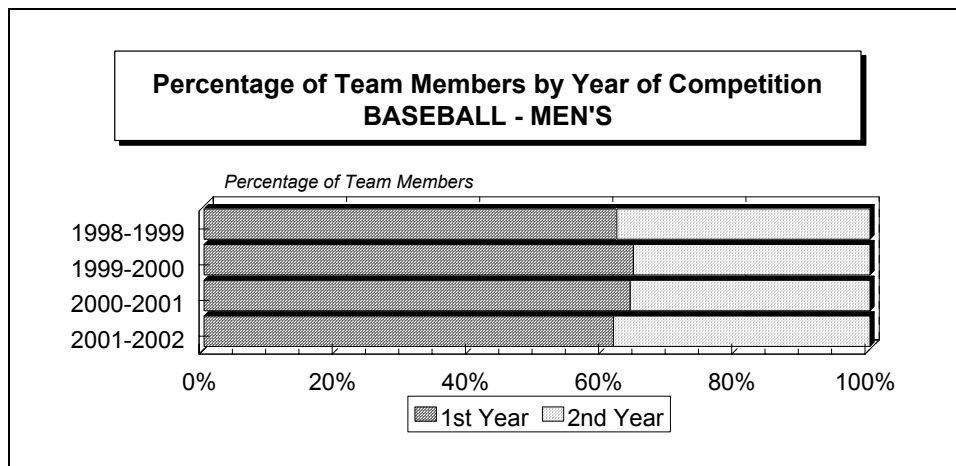

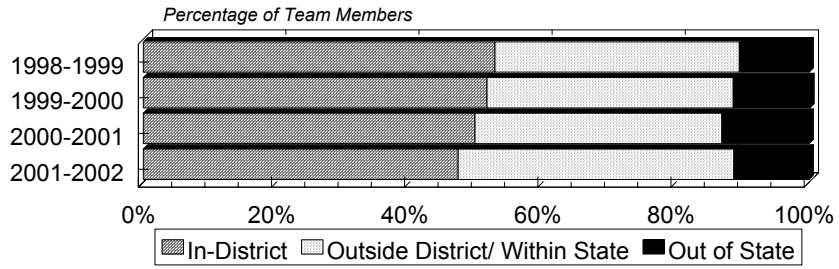

Over the past four years, there has been little change in year of competition data for men's and women's basketball teams. In addition, the proportion of first-year to second-year players remains about the same for men's and women's teams.

In regard to recent residence/location of high school data, women's basketball teams have a greater percentage of players from within the district as compared to men's teams. Primarily accounting for this difference is the finding that the percentage of men's basketball team players from out of state has remained about double the percentage of women's basketball team players. In 2001-2002, 9% of women's basketball players as compared to 20% of men's basketball players were from out of state.

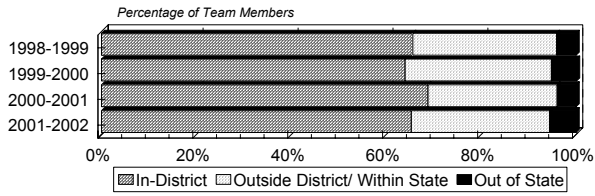

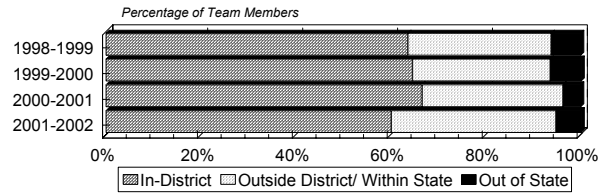

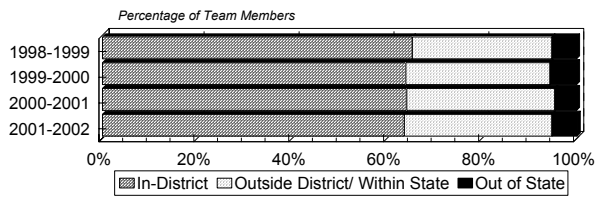
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition
SOCCER - WOMEN'S**



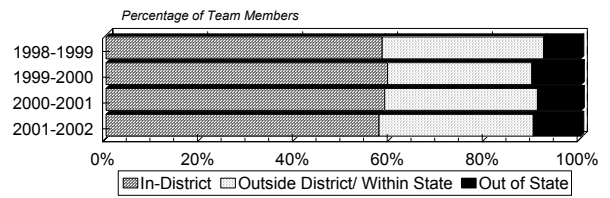
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition

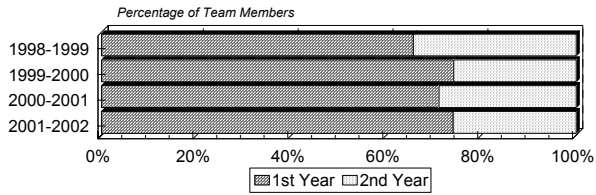

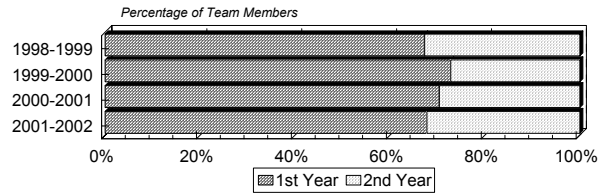

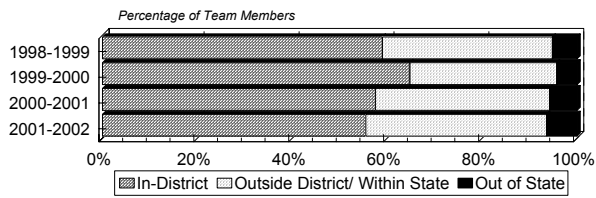
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition
SWIMMING - WOMEN'S**



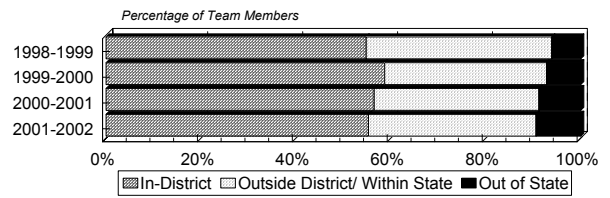
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition

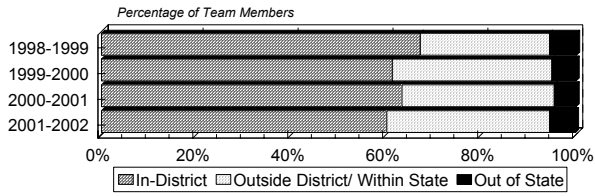

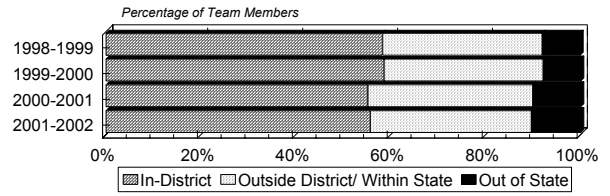

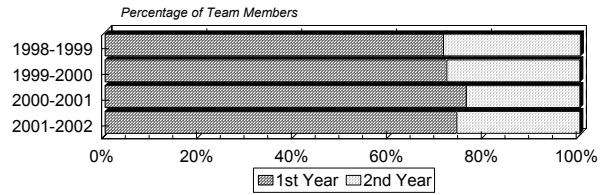

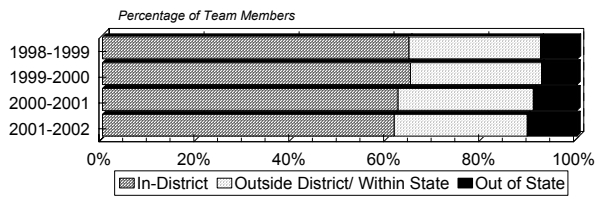
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition
VOLLEYBALL - WOMEN'S**



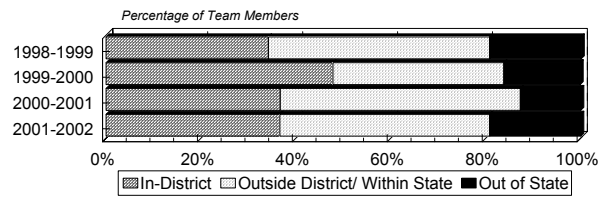
**Percentage of Team Members by Year of Competition
